Please note, the fees above are not required for children accessing their funded entitlement only. In all other cases, the Acceptance Fee is a refundable deposit, returned when the required notice is given for your child to leave the nursery. Nursery School Sessions:

Morning (AM) Sessions run from 8.00am - 2.15pm - Drop Off 8.00am - 9.15am, Pick Up 2.00pm - 2.15pm
Afternoon (PM) Sessions run from 2.15pm - 6.00pm - Drop Off 2.15pm to 2.30pm, Pick Up 5.30pm - 6.00pm
Full Day (FD) Sessions run from 8.00am - 6.00pm - Drop Off 8.00am to 9.15am, Pick Up 5.30pm - 6.00pm

Late Collection:

£20.00 per every fifteen minutes of lateness after 6.00pm. The fee applies at any point in each fifteen minutes of late collection.

Nursery School Fees:

All eligible children can access their funded hours at no cost.

Funded hours are provided at no charge. The 'Funded Fee' columns reflect the cost of additional hours and voluntary extras for each booking pattern. Government funding only covers the cost of the provision of childcare and the delivery of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). The funding does not include any of the other services that our nurseries provide, which include:

- Enrichment activities such as French, drama, creative movement, and nature studies
- Meals and snacks
- Consumables such as hygiene supplies, sun cream, and self-care items

** All charges for the above are voluntary for children accessing funded hours. Parents may opt out of any or all.*

The fees above show the amount you would pay for your child's place if taking a combination of funded hours, voluntary extras, and sessions that are not covered by the Government funding. Our voluntary extras are £25 per week for food and £250 per week for other consumables.

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Extra Nursery Sessions:

Extra nursery sessions will be charged at a rate of £135 for a morning session, £87 for an afternoon session, or £170 for a full day.

Adhoc Nursery Sessions:

Parents wishing their children to attend "one off" adhoc sessions will be charged at a rate of £139 for a morning session, £105 for an afternoon session, or £182 for a full day. Unfortunately, we are unable to offer a refund should you subsequently cancel the session.

Payment Information:

We request that all nursery school fees are paid by half term of the preceding term. Payment details and the amounts you will need to pay will be sent to you in an invoice through our parent app, as well as information on late payment charges should we need to apply them.

Tax-Free Childcare:

Tax-Free Childcare is a Government service to help working parents with the cost of their childcare. For every £8 a parent pays into their childcare account, the Government will pay an extra £2, up to a maximum of £2,000 every year for each child.
